

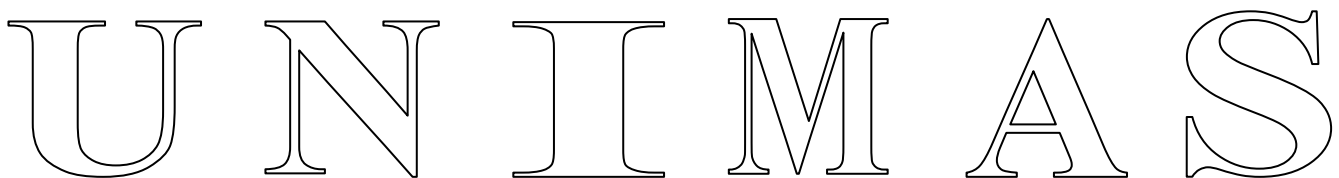

**MINIMUM REQUIREMENT**
